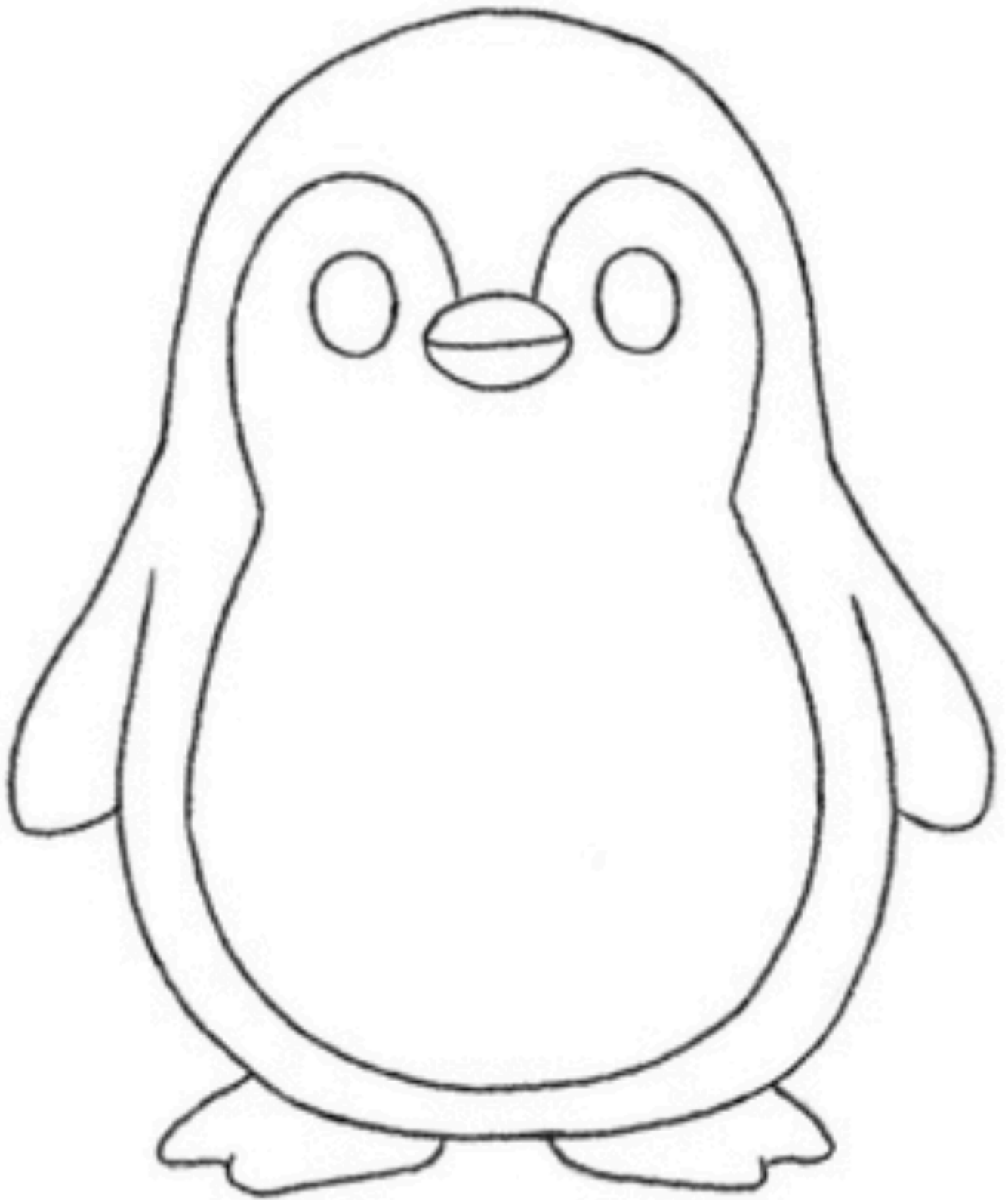
## Penguin of the Week
