A Day at Parkcrest

THE INS & OUTS OF A TYPICAL DAY

First swimmers in the pool each day are the early morning adults getting in their laps while the pool is still peaceful.

Then, the swim team groups start rolling in at 6:45AM, with all groups finishing at 11:00AM. Swim team parents are not required to stay during practices. If you would like to stay, please observe from the upper deck.

Morning lessons begin at 11:00AM. All participants should know their class level and find their instructors on the deck outside of the guard house. Instructors will announce the level they are teaching, not the names of students. Swim, dive, and water ballet lessons, and fitness classes are all 25 minutes.

All morning activities enter through the side gate (on Inner Drive). All food and drinks (besides water) should be kept to the upper deck, all day, every day.

During all morning activities, all caretakers, siblings, and anyone else not participating in lessons at that time are asked to keep the main deck clean and stay on the upper deck during practices and lessons.



At 1:00PM, the entire property is reserved for adult members only; kids are welcome to join Lunch Bunch (see below). At 1:45PM the side gate closes, and open swim begins for the afternoon; be sure to check in at the front desk on your way in. Water Ballet show groups practice in parts of both pools throughout the afternoon.

Evening lessons run from 5:30PM – 6:30PM and again enter through the side (Inner Drive) gate. Open swim resumes for the evening until closing time (or special events).

Throughout the whole day, our staff is working hard to keep Parkcrest safe and clean. Thank them for every whistle blow and fresh roll of TP!

After the busyness of the weekday mornings, Parkcrest has set aside 45 minutes in the early afternoon for the adults. But, where are all of the kids?! LUNCH BUNCH!
