What's New?

The project continues to move forward with great momentum. Crews successfully poured the lap pool floor and have partially backfilled around the deep-end pool walls, marking another major milestone for the aquatic area.

Mechanical and plumbing progress stayed on track as the underground piping for the second surge tank was installed, along with the new water heater and filtration system. Work on the remaining pool equipment within the pump house has also been progressing smoothly.

Several exciting activities are set to begin in the next few weeks including installation of the cement board siding and standing seam metal roof of the pump house, forming of the shallow-end lap pool walls, and excavation activities for the bioretention pond within the existing parking lot.

DID YOU KNOW?

Concrete trucks, or mixers, use a rotating drum with internal fins to keep concrete mixed and prevent hardening during transport, typically within a 90-minute window. These heavy machines, patented in 1916, can carry 6–10 cubic meters of concrete—weighing over 30 tons—and often use reverse rotation to discharge the load.
